REPORT.

The Committee on Rules, to whom was referred House resolution No. 374, have had the same under consideration and report the following in lieu thereof:

Resolved, That immediately after the adoption hereof the bill (S. 569) to establish a Department of Commerce shall be the special and continuing order of business until the same shall be finally disposed of, not, however, to interfere with appropriation bills, conference reports, or other special orders heretofore made, or matters of privilege under the rules, and said bill shall be considered in Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union.
