A BILL

To amend the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 to permit the Secretary of the Interior to make certain grants in excess of the 50 per centum limitation contained in such Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 102 of the Act of October 15, 1966, entitled
4 "An Act to establish a program for the preservation of addi-
5 tional historic properties throughout the Nation, and for other
6 purposes" (80 Stat. 915; 16 U.S.C. 470b) is amended by
7 redesignating subsection (d) as subsection (e) and by inserting
8 the following new subsection after subsection (c):
