A BILL

To amend the Export Administration Act of 1979 to extend the provisions relating to the export of domestically produced crude oil.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 7(d) of the Export Administration Act of 1979
4 (50 U.S.C. App. 2406(d)) is amended by adding at the end
5 thereof the following new paragraph:

6 “(4) The termination provisions contained in section 20
7 of this Act shall not apply to this subsection.”.
