Mr. MATHIAS introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To establish a Cabinet-level committee to coordinate programs to increase exports.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the President shall establish a permanent interdepart-
4 mental committee to coordinate programs to increase exports
5 of United States products and commodities. The committee
6 shall be composed of the Secretary of State, the Secretary of
7 Agriculture, the Secretary of Commerce, the Secretary of
8 Labor, the Special Representative for Trade Negotiations,
9 and the heads of such other departments or agencies as the

1 President considers advisable. The President shall designate
2 one of the members of the committee to serve as chairman.

3 SEC. 2. The committee established under the first sec-
4 tion shall report its activities, and the results of its efforts to
5 increase exports, to the Senate and the House of Representa-
6 tives each month while the Congress is in session. Such re-
7 ports may include such recommendations for legislation as
8 the committee considers desirable.
