

eBooks on EBSCOhost:

How to download to your PC & compatible eReaders.



Find an eBook in our Collection



View in browser or Checkout/Download



Open with Adobe Digital Editions—Saves as PDF



Connect to eReader to computer



Drag the title over to eReader icon



Download to Apple devices with Bluefire app

What Do You Need?

- A computer in HCHB that has access to EBSCOhost eBooks and Adobe Digital Editions (we have both in the library)
- A free EBSCOhost account to checkout or download titles
- A compatible eReader, Apple device, or PC to read the book on.
- A cord to plug your eReader into the PC (unless you have an Apple device)

Create a free EBSCO account

- Visit [eBooks online](#) and click on “Sign In” along the top of the page
- Click “Create a new Account”
- Enter the relevant information and remember your Username and Password
- Use your new Username and Password to “Sign In”

Checkout and Download to PC

- Search and select the book that you would like by clicking on it
- Click “Download This eBook (Offline)” on the left hand side
- Select “Checkout & Download”
- When the File Download box open select “Open” and the eBook will open in Adobe Digital Editions.

Transfer to eReaders Compatible with Adobe Digital Editions

Examples: Nook, Kobo or Sony readers. Kindle is not compatible.

- Connect your eReader to your computer using its own USB cable.
- Adobe Digital Editions will show your eReader as an icon on the left.
- Click on the title of the eBooks you borrowed, and drag it to the eReader icon. Let go when the green plus sign appears.
- To confirm transfer, click on the eReader icon and look for the title.
- Safely eject your eReader by clicking on the icon in the system tray.

Download to Apple devices (iPhone, iPod touch, or iPad)

- Install the free Bluefire reading app available from iTunes.
- Using the wifi connection in the library download the eBook with Safari, and then tap to open in Bluefire.
